Received by the SCTA included a reminder by the IRS to continue submission of E-filing, this will be seen to by the president. The SCTA board is also communicating with individuals who possess some land holdings that are possible future venues for Trials events. A board scouting expedition is being scheduled for June.

Old Business:

SDTR Corral Canyon event was a hit in all regards. Perfect weather and great sections. Plonkers had to scramble to a new venue for their March event due to BLM/Paperwork issues. An excellent trial at Cahuilla was put together in limited time due to snow during the set up weekend. Nice job all around. VOTE put up an epochal last round of the Championship and El Trial de Espana. Absolutely terrific event both days, poorly attended due to cold and very boisterous weather. Excellent work an all accounts from the VOTE regulars. Due to poor turnout ETDE produced less income than planned.

New Business:

The president provided insight into needed editorial changes to the Rule Book for 2011/2012.

Changes to membership fees, club rider fees, Twin Shock/Vintage line to ride definition, 2 class ride charges will be included. Due to the fluid promotional and insurance environment entry fee language will reflect where to find current entry fees once they are decided and posted website and fliers.

It was decided that due to losses incurred with ETDE that no SCTA donations will occur.

The need for SCTA to host a National was discussed at length. The board does feel it is necessary to host a National event in the near future to maintain our national stature with NATC. Venues and Organization and personnel difficulties will need to be addressed. Moto Ventures have offered their help, additionally, certain other personalities will be needed to make this effort work.

The 2011/2012 Championship Calendar and the venues at which they will take place were discussed. It seems that BLM is softening on some requirements that allows the board to sigh a qualified sigh of relief. Insurance and Medical services requirements will still require some significant changes to how we conduct our events, but the friendlier stance from the BLM/Forest gives us hope that we will be able to easily meet their requirements. Nothing official or in writing, but the "Jungle Drums" are sounding positive.
